Vicar's Letter

Dear friends

Have you ever felt like simply turning off the TV or radio because the news is so depressing? We all care about what's going on, but sometimes we may feel we are getting bad news overload — we feel powerless to change things and the temptation is simply to forget about it and think about something nice for a change.

So today I want to give you some good news. It is about another issue that concerns us all, which affects absolutely everybody the world over and about which we may well be tempted to feel that same sense of powerlessness - the environment. Nearly every day there is something on the news about it. And the latest is that we only have 11 years left to stop runaway global warming from completely devastating our planet. It sounds terribly gloomy, and perhaps you are already thinking 'I'm going to turn the page because this is just more bad news.' Stop! There's good news!

The good news is that this is something we genuinely can do something about – and there is still time (just!) All we need to do is work together, and we really can make change happen. Not only that but I'm proud to say that our lovely county of Suffolk is actually leading the way. How good is that?

Twelve months ago the C of E in Suffolk launched a new policy designed to make a real difference in every (church) parish in the county. We agreed that because we believe God gave us this beautiful earth, it's our job to look after it. As part of that we pledged to get an 'Eco Diocese' award within the year, by getting our churches working together to do things like switch to green energy, turn churchyards into wildflower meadows and provide nest boxes for endangered bird and bat species. We've worked on cutting down travel, putting solar panels on our vicarages and working out our carbon emissions so that we can reduce them. This week I can announce that we have achieved the first (bronze) level of award in record time, and we are pressing on towards silver and then gold. We can see a change already, and we are going for it! Great news!

Then this morning I read that Suffolk County Council has voted almost unanimously to declare a climate emergency, to work to become carbon neutral within that all-important 11 year span. Brilliant news!

That's two county-wide institutions showing that when you take something seriously enough, you really can make change happen.

We are not powerless. Will you join in with this good news story?

ROAD CLOSURES

UK Power Networks are in the process of installing approximately 25km of high voltage electricity cables as part of a reinforcement scheme between Burwell and Lakenheath. The first closure was between The Street, Freckenham and Fordham Road in Freckenham. This section is due to reopen on 30th March. The second closure sees the road between The Street, Freckenham, and The Street Worlington, at the junction of Newmarket Road, being closed from 30th March to 1st June. The third closure will be between The Street, Worlington, at the junction of Isleham Road and Mill Street, Mildenhall at the junction with Station Road, Barton Mills. The planned date for this closure is between 1st June and 30th June. Further information can be found on our website in regards to the closures and diversions that will be in place.

Afterwards, we all had a go at making a bee, enjoyed refreshments and a raffle.



Advice about flowers/plants on graves.

It is worth knowing that certain plants likely to be placed on a grave are favoured by muntjac deer. They love tulips, eating the flowers and leaving headless stalks. Roses are also highly favoured and primroses are likely to be eaten. Daffodils are not taken.

Also, in the recent winds, many artificial flowers on wire stems placed in the perforated holders had blown around - they need to be weighed down to prevent movement.




