4. Affordable Housing

Faith Rutterford asked about the vetting process of potential tenants and buyers. Robert Lewis said the Parish Council would be involved in the process and that occupiers must be from the village but, if there is insufficient demand, the Parish Council could dictate who would be prioritised next (probably Tuddenham and Worlington residents). He said it is most likely the Parish Council would have to choose from candidates within the village. Hastoe will manage the properties and ensure tenants behave appropriately. When tenants or buyers move on, the process will be repeated. He assured Faith Rutterford that any problems (including during construction) could be reported to the Clerk or direct to Hastoe who would deal with them.

The Retreat - Frances Lewis asked about the crossing at the old dairy site. Tim Huggan advised that this was deemed unaffordable but that road markings could be put in and suggested asking the County Councillor about this.
